RACE DATE: Saturday, April 20, 2024

SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY.

We want everyone to have a great day of racing. Please remember sportsmanship above a race time. If someone needs help, give them a hand. Please communicate with fellow racers; holes, turns, changing lines, vehicles, stopping.... Call it out! Slower racers make sure you stay to the far right of the road. Faster riders make sure to communicate passes and give slower riders ample room.

RULES OF THE ROAD

The racecourse is on roads open to automobile traffic, so please stay on your side of the road and obey traffic signals. We have Sheriffs stationed on busy intersections & volunteer corner marshals on many corners. Follow their instructions including stopping, **<u>it's for your own safety!!</u>**

SAG SUPPORT & EMERGENCY["] All racers will have an emergency sticker on the back of their number plate. For an emergency call or text 911 for ambulance. **IN THE EVENT YOU DON'T HAVE CELL SERVICE, TEXT 911** for help.

For non-serious injury call sag # (616) 379-9302 you will be taken to the aid station or back to Hastings. If you are separated from your bike or personal belongings, they will be brought to the Barry Community Foundation building next to the awards stage.

* You can only pick up your own race packet! ID Required


- * Please <u>know your BIB #</u>. You can also look up your BIB # through printed copies or QR code
- * You'll sign a printed waiver and exchange your waiver for number plate
- * If you <u>pre-ordered merchandise</u> with your registration, you'll have a sticker on the back of your number plate stating <u>"MERCH</u>". Proceed to the merchandise table to pick up your purchased items.



RACER DETAIL: NAME, BIB#, RACE CATEGORY, START WAVE, START TIME:

This information will be emailed once registration closes. You can view all racers details <u>HERE</u>

RACE COURSES: The race course is very well marked* with some permanent signs as well as race day signs & arrows. Follow the arrow corresponding with your race; 18 = Blue, 36 = Yellow, 62 = Red. We also have sheriffs and volunteer marshals on many corners, please obey their instructions for your safety. *The 100 Mile Psycho is not signed*

RACE COURSE MAPS & GPS FILES:

STARTING WAVES & START TIMES: (Eastern Standard Time)

- * Your Specific wave & time is listed on back of race plate.
- * We will also email you the link to your exact BIB#, start time and start wave
- * Please do not bend, fold, cut or trim your race plate. It should be tied to your handlebar

* We will only stage 3 start waves deep in the race chute at a time to spread out racers We'll have big signs in the start corral identifying each wave distance and wave number. Here's how it works: First number is the distance and second is the wave start withing that distance. So, if you see "36-4" that's the 36-mile race and start wave 4.

ON COURSE AID STATIONS: Our on-course aid stations are staffed with volunteers offering: SKRATH LABS nutrition and hydration, Gordon water, and Fruit. Aid stations will also have emergency personnel and a bike mechanic and porta jons.

DISTANCE TO EACH AID STATIONS:

100-mile aid at miles 41, 62, 88
62-mile aid at miles 22 & 43
36-mile aid at mile 22
18-mile aid at mile 9.3
*We also have a finish line recovery tent with recovery food and hydration

RACER CUT-OFF TIMES: For the safety of racers there will be cut off times for the 100- and 62mile distances. ** ANY RACER PULLED FOR TIME CUT OFF WILL RECEIVE A RIDE BACK TO HASTINGS FROM AN AID STATION SAG VEHICLE**

100 - mile cut off: Racers need to make it to the following aid stations by the designated time. Times will be adjusted if the race starts after 7 AM

- race start to the McCallum Church aid station (mile 41) by 11:30 AM
- race start to the Cedar Creek aid station (mile 62) by 1:15 PM
- race start to Pierce Cedar Creek Institute aid station (mile 88) by 4:00 PM

<u>62- mile cut off</u>: Racers need to make it to the Cedar Creek Rd. aid station at mile 43 by 3:00 PM (10.8 mph avg. pace)

*Finish line timing equipment will be pulled around 6pm as we need to re-open Green St.

SCRATCH / DNF / WRONG RACE DISTANCE:

We want to account for all racers as well as assist our timing team with accurate results. If you didn't complete your correct race distance, please DO NOT cross the finish line. Please text; 269-205-8866 and your BIB # along with full name DNF = Did Not Finish DQ = Wrong distance, picked up, etc...



**Hastings MI is located approx. 40 min drive from Grand Rapids, Kalamazoo and Lansing, MI. which all offer many hotel options.

RV's and Campers: The city of Hastings opens Tyden Park and allows campers to park overnight. This is first come first served with approx. 15 spots. <u>304 N Broadway St; Hastings, Michigan 49058.</u>

CHANGE OF CLOTHES: To enjoy the after-party be sure to bring a change of clothes that's weather appropriate. We will have two big fires burning in the Hastings City fire pits along with a beer tent and food vendors.

DOGS IN AFTER-PARTY: We are animal lovers and you're welcome to bring your well-behaved dog to the after-party but they must be on a leash.

LOST AND FOUND: Any items that are found or lost, please check with the awards prize tent.

FINISH LINE: We have a **SQUIRT CYCLING PRODUCTS** Bike wash station with hoses and washing materials. We also have a racer recovery tent sponsored by **SKRATCH LABS** with Repair recovery drink along with Bars and fruit and water provided by **GORDON WATER**. We also have a **COREWELL HEALTH PENNOCK** medical triage tent near the finish line for minor injuries.

BARRY-ROUBAIX MERCHANDISE:

Pre-purchased merchandise: Pick up at any of the packet pick up locations. Merchandise for sale: we will have T-shirts, hats, jerseys, sweatshirts and posters for sale at packet pick-up locations and in the after-party area. Sizes and styles are limited and available as long as supplies last.

RULES: 2024 BARRY-ROUBAIX (subject to change)

- Don't be a jerk! Everyone's looking to enjoy the day, don't be "that person"
- All race courses are open to auto traffic, and may include the occasional horse back rider. Obey all traffic laws, instructions from Sheriff Marshals and volunteer corner marshals at intersections. Only roll through if you are directed to do so. <u>You may be asked to stop for your own safety</u>.
- I repeat, the course will NOT be closed to traffic and cycling rules of the road apply, i.e. stop at all stop signs, yield to cars, no more than 2 riders abreast and do not cross yellow center line. Violations could be penalized by disqualification
- **100-mile riders:** A rear blinking light is REQUIRED equipment for safety. With a sunrise start it's important to be visible on course.
- Number plates must be handlebar mounted. To reduce scoring errors and issue; DO NOT CUT, FOLD, WRAP OR BEND YOUR PLATE!!!!! Number plates will have a disposable timing chip attached to the back. Also only place your plate on the bars; Not on your back, hydration pack, pocket, etc. Any scoring errors resulting from a modified or improperly mounted (read: wrapped on the head tube) number plate will NOT be corrected.
- 62 and 100 Mile cut-off time:

For your safety we have the following cut-off times in place:

- 100 mile racers @ McCallum Church (mile 41) 11:30 AM
- 100 mile racers @ Cedar Creek Church (mile 62) 1:15 PM
- 62 mile racers @ Cedar Creek Church (mile 44) 3 PM
- 100 mile racers @ Pierce Cedar Creek Aid (mile 88) 4 PM
- Note: chip timing equipment will be pulled around 5-5:30pm as we need to re-open Green St. (M-37) to traffic. If you finish after that time you may not get a finish result.
- Be aware that corner marshals and sheriffs will not stay at their post until the very last rider. Once the "majority" of racers have passed they will leave, at this point you can still follow the course markings but no one will be stopping traffic for you. Follow the rules of the road.
- If you didn't complete your registered race distance, do not cross the finish line and inform the timing team for results accuracy.
- Any physical altercations will result in disqualification.
- Cheaters aren't welcome. If you've been found guilty of cheating/doping by USAC or other races, we have the right to deny you from racing and will remove you from results listings if caught in a year you raced BRX.
- The event organizers reserve the right to delay, reschedule or cancel the race due to, but not limited to include; weather, emergencies and any unforeseen situations that may put at risk the safety of the racers, spectators, volunteers and general public. <u>No refunds</u> will be provided, however the race organizers may offer registrants a partial refund or credit to a future race.
- ANSI approved helmets are mandatory
- Currently we do not allow E-bikes. We are evaluating ways to safely integrate them into our event in the future.
- Recumbents, elliptical bikes, three wheeled bikes, or trailers are not allowed at the event. This rule does not apply to Para-cycling equipment.
- No ear buds / music allowed
- All bicycles much be equipped with at least 1 hand operated brake.
- No tri-bars or aero bars allowed in 18, 36 or 62 mile events (**EXCEPTION**: They **ARE** allowed for the 100-mile Psycho Killer)
- Motor pacing is not allowed
- If you can not ride a steep hill or loose sand, stay to the far right so others can pass by while riding
- Littering of any kind is not allowed and will be grounds for disqualification
- Starting in the wrong wave will result in disqualification! Do NOT line up in the wave in front of yours in an attempt to get a front row spot in your registered wave. We will remove your number plate if you're caught doing this!
- Family and friends; to reduce vehicle traffic on the course please keep cars completely off race route roads. Especially stay off Sager Rd during the race. Do not even think of driving or parking there!
- Riders are not allowed to receive support or hand-ups from family/friends/crews on the course. You must rely on the aid stations available on course. If you have specific nutrition/items that you require during the race you will need to carry them with you.
- Unregistered riders are not allowed to ride with race participants
